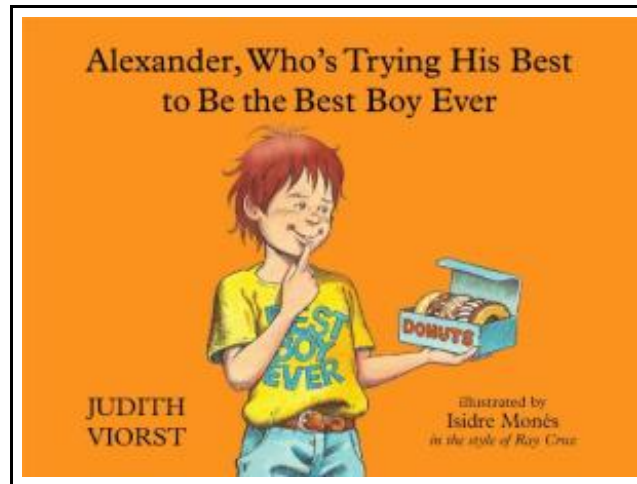

## ALEXANDER, WHO'S TRYING HIS BEST TO BE THE BEST BOY EVER

It's been more than 40 years since Judith Viorst introduced her intrepid (if occasionally grouchy) 5-year-old hero in *Alexander and the Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Day*, winning the hearts of millions of readers 4 to 7 and their parents. In his fourth book, Alexander begins thinking about consequences. "Last night somebody ate a whole box of jelly doughnuts and hid the empty box under the couch," he begins. "I'm not saying who that somebody is, but this morning, when I woke up, I had a bellyache." It gets worse when Mom finds the box and takes away his TV and video game privileges, to avoid any more consequences, Alexander tries to be the Best Boy Ever but it's not easy, especially when he thinks about the fun he's missing. Illustrator Isidre Monés perfectly captures the look of Ray Cruz's classic ink drawings, with Alexander himself in color. "Another winner about mischievous Alexander, who this time is trying to be the Best Boy Ever after his latest disastrous escapade. Viorst's text is right on target as usual, hilariously describing the boy's thoughts: 'I'm thinking how much I love eating jelly doughnuts. And I'm thinking how much I hate having consequences. And I'm thinking I hate those consequences much, much, much, much more than I love doughnuts.' On Sunday he thinks, 'Everyone's still asleep, and I'm still walking around on tiptoes. But it's lonesome. And I'm thinking that if I went out the front door and rang the doorbell five, six, seven times, no one would be sleeping anymore.' Kids will surely identify with Alexander's trials and tribulation either in a group situation or at home with a long-suffering parent, who will probably get a kick out of the book, too." *School Library Journal* 40.
